

Declarations over Self after Deliverance

The Word says that we must fill our house after deliverance. (Matthew 12:43-45). One way to fill your house is to decree and declare the Word of God over yourself. Fill your house with the Word of God as it pertains to the area where you received deliverance. Use these declarations as a starting point and add more as the Holy Spirit leads you.

Victory over Bitterness Declarations

Lord I have the heart of the Father.

I forgive as You forgive. I choose to release others totally and completely so that they may be forgiven and blessed by You (John 20:23).

Lord, I have a heart of repentance and a mind of repentance.

I quickly repent when I have sinned. I am kind and tender-hearted forgiving others even as God in Christ forgave me (Matt. 6:14-15).

I have a willing heart to forgive others 70 x 7 (Matt. 18:21- 22).

I am quick to forgive (Eph. 4:26).

I forgive myself as I have forgiven others. I am humble, and I do not exalt myself above the knowledge of You, Lord (2 Cor. 10:5).

I take every thought captive to the obedience of Christ. (2 Cor. 10:5)

I love my enemies and bless those who curse me.

I do good to those who spitefully use and persecute me through the power of the Holy Spirit (Matt. 5:44).

I look to You and no other for validation for You are my comforter and lifter of my head (Psalm 3:3).

Victory over Accusation Declarations
